ST. BLAISE DAY-FEBRUARY 3-MASS 6:30 P.M.

On Wednesday, Feb. 3, 6:30 P.M. mass, St. Blaise Day, the blessing of St. Blaise will be given. Two candles are consecrated, generally by a prayer, the candles are held in a crossed position by the priest over the heads of the faithful or touched on the throat with the candles.

St. Blaise was a physician at Sebaste before he was raised to the Episcopal See. At the time of the persecution under Licinius he was taken prisoner at the command of the governor, Agricolaus. The hunters of the governor found him in a wilderness cave to which he had retired. While he was in prison he performed a wonderful cure of a boy who had a fishbone in his throat and was in danger of choking to death. After suffering various forms of torture, St. Blaise was beheaded.
