Bishop Oscar Cantu will lead us with prayer and Commemorate the Appearance of the Blessed Mother of Fatima.

On May 13, 1917, a bright, sunny Sunday, after attending Mass, three children, Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco took their flocks out to Cova da Iria where the Blessed Mother of Fatima (Portugal) appeared to them. It was a difficult time for people because of World War I and the Revolution in Russia that year. Both, the war and revolution, took away lives of millions of innocent people. When we read about Jacinta, Francisco and Lucia, who survived both, we learn that the Blessed Mother many times asked the children to pray for the conversion of Russia. In Fatima, the Blessed Mother asked also, that they pray for the conversion of sinners. The Blessed Mother appeared with the Rosary in her hands, and she asked children to pray the Rosary every day because conversion and the Holy Rosary are the instruments of our salvation and the salvation of others as well.

In our times, we also have witnessed wars and revolutions and they are as dangerous as the ones that have passed. Unborn children are destroyed through abortion, euthanasia accepted and divorces make fun of sanctity, and so on.

In memory of this day, May 13, mass will begin at 7:00 p.m. followed by a Procession of Light with the statue of the Blessed Mother of Fatima to be blessed by Bishop Cantu during the celebration.
